
## An Anniversary, a Fall, and Three Cute Paramedics




Humble celebration for Mom's 70th Anniversary

## It's Happening!

For centuries, most missionaries have gone out from first world countries. Now God is calling more and more people in the two-thirds world to serve Him by

taking the Good News around the globe. Just like us, they need training in order to be as effective as possible. As you know, Robert has been developing online courses to provide this training. But he hadn't yet discerned the best organization to partner with in disseminating the courses. And so we prayed and asked you to pray.

Our prayers have been answered wonderfully! Robert recently began working in conjunction with an online ministry training school in Costa Rica called ProMETA (prometa.info, in case you'd like to check it out) to help equip third world missionaries and pastors to carry out God's call on their lives. ProMETA offers courses at certificate, diploma, and Masters levels. Robert will be applying his many years of academic experience in teaching, course development, and program development to this collaborative effort. This partnership expands the availability of his courses, and lends his expertise to the ongoing ministry of preparing people for cross-cultural service, in Latin America and around the world. It feels to us as though God has been grooming Robert for this ministry his whole life.

A recent statistic that we came across is that there are currently approximately 24,000 Latin Americans involved in intercultural ministry and missions. It is estimated that of these, **about 80% are lacking any kind of specific ministry training** to help them be more effective in their ministries. ProMETA is one attempt to provide this necessary training to Spanish speakers around the world, and we are thrilled to be a part of it.
