

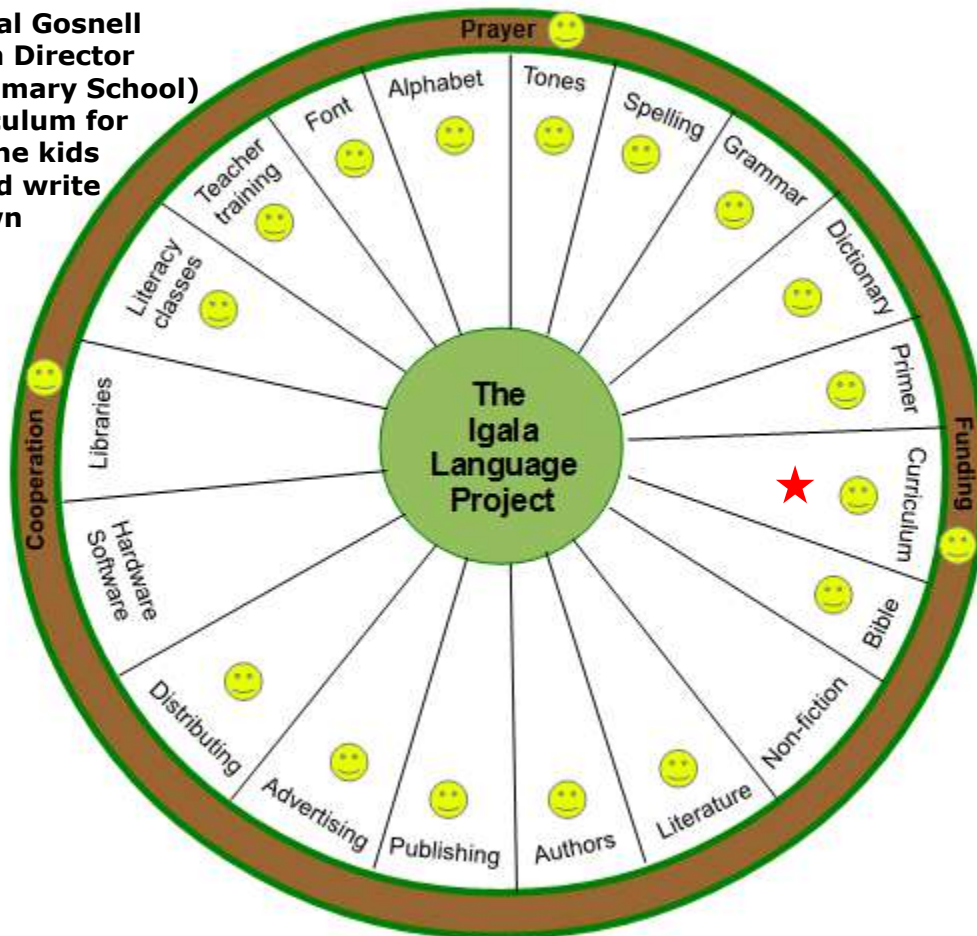
Igala Language Project Snippet May 2014
