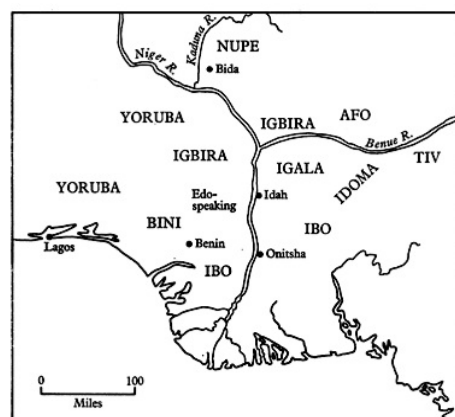
God willing, I will leave on August 19 for Nigeria,
