NEW ARRIVAL Aminat, a little preemie girl was brought to Otutulu on Sept. 21. Her mother died in childbirth. The dad, a Muslim who has made his pilgrimage to Mecca, confessed that ordinarily he would not have dreamed of coming to a place like MoM Otutulu. He was full of praises to God, seeing our kids on the compound. He has asked us to care for his baby for two years. Please let all of us be on our knees for this baby to make it. The little services we render do take the gospel to compounds, families, and communities that we wouldn't ordinarily have been able to reach especially with the current trends in some parts of the country.

URGENT PRAYER REQUESTS

Pray that our Lord will provide us with people that are really called to work with this Ministry. We need more "aunties" and "uncles" to care for the children day and night. And we need administrative and support personnel.

Pray that our innocent women do not die giving birth.

Pray that we are able to complete the Ministry of Mercy Medical Center and begin serving our pregnant women medically and surgically at no cost.

Pray for preemie Aminat and for one-year-old Aminetu who won't eat. She is on intravenous support, but we don't know what is wrong.

Pray for our 191 children in various schools. The costs for this term total about \$15,000. This is a great burden for us, but we trust in God's promises.
