Urgent Prayer Request

Sunday night (11/8) some Hausa Fulani people (nomadic herdsmen) invaded Esther Edeh's village and killed about 17 people. They had recently attacked another community and killed about three men working on their farm. Both attacks were not far from Otutulu. There are strong rumors that these Fulani people are likely to invade Otutulu Village and Orphanage. So far, no further attacks.

Please surround our orphanages with His Armies of Angels. Be on your knees on behalf of all the children and staff of Ministry of Mercy Orphanages as well as the nearby communities.

Please pray for peace to reign.
