Pray for the health and safety of the children of MoM and for all those serving them – Daniel and Esther Edeh, all the “Aunties”, the medical and school staff, and all the administrative and support staff..

Some of the health issues are malaria, sickle cell anemia, typhoid, HIV/AIDS, high blood pressure, diabetes, injuries, allergies, asthma, and infections and illnesses that resist diagnosis and treatment.

Some of the safety issues are dangers on the road, armed robbers, kidnappers, deadly conflicts between subsistence farmers and cattle-herders, poisonous snakes, scorpions, and insect bites.

Please pray for the spiritual health and safety of all, as well. The staff need grace to stand up under the heavy load of responsibility that each bears, and to love, nurture, and guide the growing children.

We ask that you also pray for our material needs.

We daily feed about 400 children and staff.

Over 200 of our children go to school. In Nigeria, this means school fees, uniforms and supplies, and for those in year 7 and above, room and board as well. Several of our older students are in university in Nigeria or the United States.

And then there is the MoM Medical Centre which is succeeding in its purpose of saving the lives of mothers and babies by providing free care to women who cannot afford to pay, and even C-sections when necessary.
