The six years I've had with this kid so far have been nothing short of amazing! As many of you know, Eric lost his twin about 8 months ago, and he had a lot of pain and anger and sadness to work through. It's been such a privilege (and healing for me, too) to get to walk through the grief with him.

On Thursday, last week - oh the joy! - he decided to ask Jesus into his heart! And he was so excited, he couldn't wait to tell everyone he could think of: "I have so many people to tell!" he exclaimed. He started his announcement the same way each time: "I have a good news to tell you!" As we walked around so he could spread his good news, he patted his chest and said, "My heart is feeling better; is very happy."

I couldn't help but think of the parable of the widow and the lost coin and how she called everyone to celebrate with her when she found something valuable.
