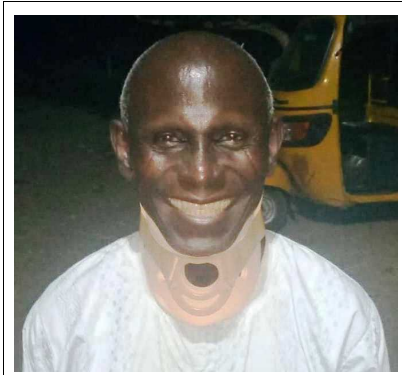

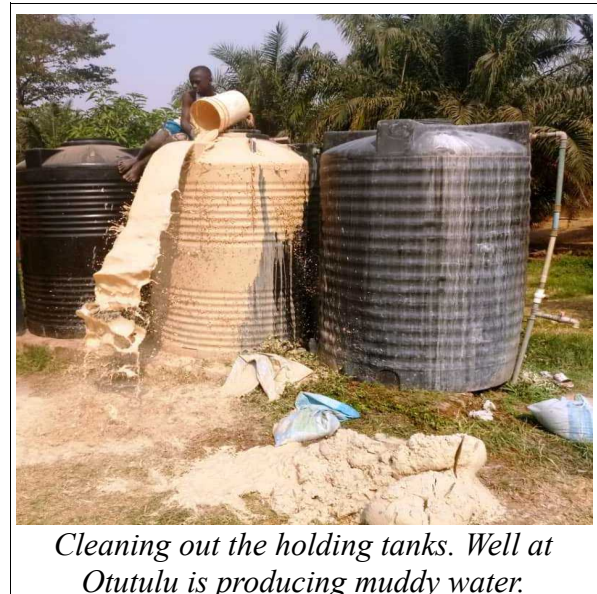
The neck brace is very helpful

Daniel is asking a group related to UNICEF to determine what needs to be done. We are hoping that drilling deeper will tap into adequate water supplies. This campus houses 100 children, the staff, and the MoM Medical Center.
- The wells and natural spring at the Otutulu campus also have problems. This campus houses 300 children and the staff.
