Dear Beloved, Please PRAY for those in our care at MoM, Lokoja, Nigeria.

A stormy rain two nights ago left us devastated. It destroyed many things including our sign board by the roadside and the wall of our perimeter fence. Trees on the compound were damaged or knocked down, and buildings at the Orphanage and the Medical Centre were damaged.
