1. Funds donated through PiJ for Storm Damage Repair so far total \$2,855. Other groups and individuals have given, too. We thank the Lord for moving hearts to give above their regular donations, or for the first time.
2. At Lokoja, the walls that collapsed have been rebuilt, and the rest of the security walls are being reinforced. They plan to add barbed wire on top as funds come in.
3. At Otutulu they are still trying to get water from the new well piped throughout the campus. They are also reinforcing the security walls around the campus.
4. COVID-19 travel restrictions make it hard to get food, formula, and other supplies for the orphanages. Kogi State closed its borders, and now shops are running out of stock and prices are much higher. It's a desperate time for thousands as well as for MoM. Our God reigns. Please pray for Nigeria and for the world.
5. Daniel and Anibe Edeh of Ministry of Mercy Orphanages came to the States in February to welcome their first grandchild – and then in March the virus hit, and they were forced to remain here due to closed borders. Please pray that they will soon find a way to return to their ministry in Nigeria. They are hoping for a flight sometime in July.
6. We've lost a dear friend and generous supporter, Steve Amendola. Pray for his wife and family as they grieve their loss while rejoicing that cancer no longer afflicts him.
